ALL CATFISH MUST BE 14" LONG AND ALIVE

CHANNEL CATFISH WILL BE RELEASED. FLATHEAD AND BLUE CATS WILL NOT BE RELEASED.

Four Landing Start: All boats must check in and be inspected before you can start fishing the tournament. Boat inspections will be at all 4 landings **ONLY IF YOU HAVE PRE-REGISTERED**. IF YOU ARE NOT PRE-REGISTERED, BOAT INSPECTION MUST BE AT GASKIN PARK LANDING. Launch and start the tournament from these landings: Registration Site-Gaskin Park Landing; Bristol Landing; Estifanulga Landing; Owl Creek-Hickory Landing. REGISTERED fishermen may TRAILER OUT from any official landing Friday at 4 pm CST to launch from any other landing.
