The trail consists of the Liberty County Sr Citizen Catfish Tournament, the Choctawhatchee Catfish Round-up, the Gator Classic Catfish Tournament and the Curtis Anders Memorial Florida Catfish Classic. You MUST fish 3 out of 4 tournaments to be eligible.

Registration: Entry fees for the Curtis Anders Memorial Florida Catfish Classic are \$50 per person; Entry fees for the Kid's Channel Catfish Classic are \$20 per person (14 years and younger). Kids wishing to fish for flathead must pay the adult rate and fish against adults. Mail entries to Florida Catfish Classic, P O Box 555, Wewahitchka, FL 32465. You can also register at Gaskin Park the day of the tournament or by dropping off your registration and fee at City Hall Annex located at 318 South 7th Street, Wewahitchka, FL 32465. ALL CATFISH MUST BE 14" LONG AND ALIVE

CHANNEL CATFISH WILL BE RELEASED. FLATHEAD AND BLUE CATS WILL NOT BE RELEASED

Four Landing Start: All boats must check in and be inspected before you can start fishing the tournament. Boat inspections will be at all 4 landings ONLY IF YOU HAVE PRE-REGISTERED. IF YOU ARE NOT PRE-REGISTERED, BOAT INSPECTION MUST BE AT GASKIN PARK LANDING. Launch and start the tournament from these landings: Registration Site-Gaskin Park Landing, Bristol Landing, Estiffanulga Landing, or Owl Creek-Hickory Landing. REGISTERED fishermen may TRAILER OUT from any official landing Friday at 4 pm CST to launch from any other landing.
